The Department has well- equipped laboratories, which includes a Biokinetics Teaching Laboratory, and we have a strong clinical link with the Sport Science Institute of South Africa. The Department offers a Bachelor of Medical Science Honours in Biokinetics and a Master of Philosophy in Biokinetics; and has a vibrant and diverse postgraduate community.

We are seeking to employ an experienced, motivated Clinical Educator in Biokinetics. This is a permanent parttime post in which the incumbent will primarily be required to teach clinical skills and provide clinical supervision in Biokinetics. The incumbent will be required to assist with the opening of a primary or secondary biokinetics practice in affiliation with the University of Cape Town. In addition, this person will also work with existing staff to assist in the planning, development, and implementation of a new four-year professional degree in Biokinetics.
